- Assist to castings and access tests (circus and theater),





Utilities


- A change in the perception of the test by the students.
- Objectives should be:
- Climate of confidence
- Good treatment and care
- Improve those dynamics, tests or exercises that involve or may be upset by students
- Raise awareness in the evaluators about the importance of good treatment and generating a friendly space

 Help evaluators to improve dynamics and clarify basic rules for students.



Important points to consider

- Incomodity of the teachers.
- Budgetary issues







Recommendations for schools

- Choosing evaluators.
- Transmit the values.
- Send the test information as complete as possible.
- Think the order of the proof
- Think well the theatrical test
- Clear rules abut touching
- Make clear when we are evaluating



Questions to be asked by schools:

- Do we want to include **diversity** in our school? **How**? Why?
- Do we want to **give value to non-hegemonic corporities** in our schools to create other references? How? Why??
- Do we want to be **updated** in themes that our student will be more updated by the generation to which he belongs? (for example, if we will have a lot of alumni LGTBIQA+, we want to be sensitized and informed about the subject so we can take more care and be closer to our student?)



Recommendations for evaluators

- Balance warm up
- Remember the rules
- Language
- **Presentation** of the observers
- Recording
- Explanation of the tests
- Rest and **caring** things
- Names and **pronouns**
- Good clima
- Physical **limitants**
- Outfit
- Physical contact
- Extra test



Recommendations for students

- Get informed or ask what the rules will be during the tests.
- If you have any doubts about specific issues, even if they are not in the rules, do not hesitate to ask them before testing.
