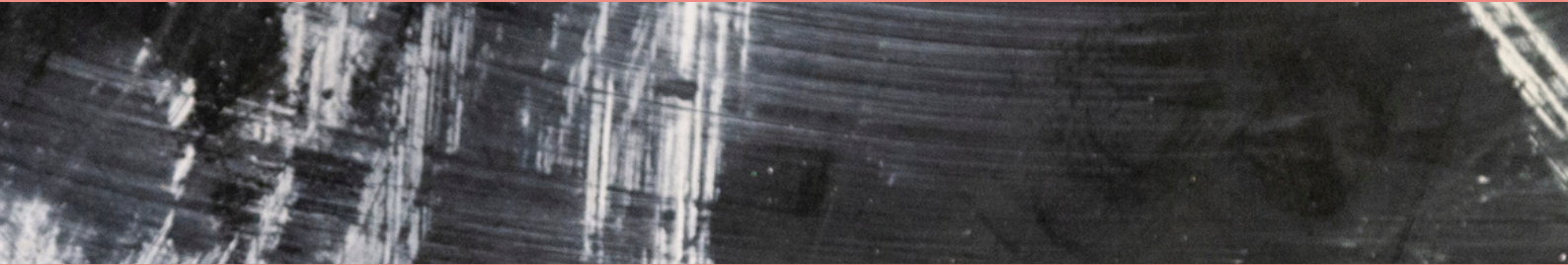

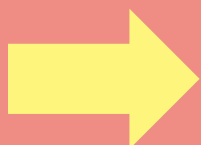
Towards Proactive Inclusivity: Relaxed Venue Policy and Practice at Battersea Arts Centre (UK)
